



TITLE IX FACTS

PARENTING AND PREGNANT STUDENTS

Title IX protects pregnant and parenting students. Title IX makes it illegal to discriminate because of sex, which includes discrimination on the basis of pregnancy, childbirth, false pregnancy, miscarriage, abortion, or related conditions, including recovery.

YOUR TITLE IX RIGHTS

- *Your absences must be excused for as long as your doctor says is medically necessary.*
- *Individual faculty cannot establish attendance rules that conflict with federal law.*
- *Be proactive: discuss & plan ahead with your faculty for a successful semester.*
- *Contact Zakiya Brown if you need assistance speaking with faculty.*
- *Keep notes (including emails and text messages) about your pregnancy-related absences, or any instances of harassment, report problems asap to Zakiya Brown.*
